S-13	S-9	S-8	1985	Not a design change. Same as the S-6. Last of the Technicolor flaps. This turquoise border flap has red lettering and W.W.W.'s. There were approximately 600 of these flaps made and were sold for \$2.50

Was changed largely due to the fact that the lodge totem was lost in the background, and the cost of making the previous patch became prohibitively high. 1 <sup>st</sup> of 7 borders of this patch. This was also known as an Ordeal flap patch. This design was known as the nuclear, silhouette, or desert night background flap patch. Error made in design of the lodge totem. 1 too few red and yellow triangles on each side of the thunderbird. No limit on how many patches you could buy. Approximately 400 of this patch were made and sold for \$2.50.
