



NAVAJO LODGE 98 ORDEAL EQUIPMENT CHECK LIST

- Wear your Scout uniform to and from the Ordeal.
- Bring all necessary sleeping gear as you would on a Troop outing.
- It does get cold in Holcomb Valley Scout Ranch at this time of the year, bring warm clothing.
- Bring you're oldest work clothes, work gloves, comfortable shoes and a hat.
- You will need to bring a pocketknife, but no more than a 3-inch blade.
- You will need your scout ten (10) essentials and a daypack to carry them in with you to include a water bottle. We will be encouraging you to drink water through out the day.
- You may want to bring some extra spending money for the lodge trading post.
- Do not bring any electronics, such as radios, c.d. players, walkmans, or alcohol or drugs. (Prescription medication will be turned in and kept for you in the health lodge.)

We cannot transport your son to or from the ordeal; we encourage the scouts to car pool with others in their area.

You must arrive at Holcomb Valley Scout Ranch between the hours of 6PM-8PM Friday night on September 24th. You may pick up your son on Saturday night or any time after 10AM on Sunday. Parents or scout leader may pick up their scouts.
