

Frequently Asked Questions About Facebook

How do you register for Facebook? Go to www.facebook.com and click on the button register for facebook. From there the site will step you through easy to follow instructions.

Are there any Venturing Groups on Facebook? Yes. Each Region has its own Facebook Group, and there are several National Facebook Groups and Sea Scouting Groups. To find the most common groups click on the search column on the upper left hand side from your home page and type in one of the following:

- Facebook Venturers (National Unofficial Group)
- Venturing, BSA (National Unofficial Group)
- Sea Scouts, BSA (National Unofficial Group)
- Southern Region Venturing (Southern Region Unofficial Group)
- Northeast Region Venturing (Northeast Region Unofficial Group)
- Western Region Venturing (Western Region Unofficial Group)
- Central Region Venturing (Central Region Unofficial Group)
- Central Region Sea Scouting (Unofficial Central Region Group)

Once you have found the group click “join this group” on the right hand side of the page.

Why does it say “Unofficial Group” next to all the Facebook Groups above?

That is because the National Scout Council does not sponsor these groups. These groups were designed by Venturers and Advisors to get information about Venturing out on a site that many of today’s teenagers and college age youth are using. It is simply asked that while you are on these sites you think about the Venturing Oath, Sea Scout Promise, and Scout Law before you post anything.
